How to close a quick release wheel skewer - the right way:



If the lever is almost impossibly tight - or loose - you must rotate the nut on the other side of the quick release.

Loosen the nut to help the lever close easily. Tighten it to make the lever

Quick release skewers close with a lever - this lever operates a cam that clamps the wheel to the bike's frame (or fork).

To secure your wheel, swing the lever to the closed position, as shown here. It may require some force to close, but it should not be difficult.





clamp with more force.

Continue adjusting the nut until the lever closes firmly, but comfortably.
